The Commission involves a range of stakeholders from the Voluntary, Public and Private Sectors. #### **The type of personal information we collect:**

We currently collect and process the following information:

Individual names and contact details when explicit consent is provided.

#### **How we get the personal information and why we have it:**

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by individuals for one of the following reasons:

To ensure that individuals have an opportunity to tell their Lived Experience Stories on the subject of Poverty or Financial Vulnerability.

We use the information that you have given us in order to publicly demonstrate the issues of Poverty and Financial Vulnerability. We do this through:

- The Poverty Truth Commission Website.
- Through various organisational Social Media Channels.
- Through discussions which influence local Policy Making on the subject of Poverty.



The Lawful Basis we rely on for processing this information is:

- (a) Your consent.
- (b) You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting [info@voluntaryimpact.org.uk](mailto:info@voluntaryimpact.org.uk).

**How we store your personal information:**

Your information is securely stored by the host organisation (Voluntary Impact Northamptonshire) and its partners. We securely hold your data for the life of the Poverty Truth Commission which is generally 24 months. We will then dispose of your personal details. All Electronic Information will be deleted. Any Paper documentation will be securely disposed of.

**Your Data Protection rights:**

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

**Your right of access** - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

**Your right to rectification** - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

**Your right to erasure** - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

**Your right to restriction of processing** - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

**Your right to object to processing** - You have the the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

**Your right to data portability** - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.
